**The Museum at Warm Springs Receives \$35,000  
Capacity and Small Project Grant from Travel Oregon**

**(WARM SPRINGS, Ore., Jan. 26, 2023)** — Travel Oregon has awarded a \$35,000 Capacity and Small Project Grant to The Museum at Warm Springs. The grant will support the development of a marketing and community development plan as well as support staff capacity with the addition of a communications and marketing contractor.

The Oregon Tourism Commission, dba [Travel Oregon](#), awarded more than \$1.4 million through its Capacity and Small Project Grant Program to help destination marketing/management organizations and federally-recognized Native nations with capacity building and targeted projects to enhance and expand economic impact through travel and tourism. Funds were awarded to 45 organizations to develop and refine skills, systems, structures and strategies to help awardees successfully fulfill their missions and achieve outcomes that are more impactful.
